



Information about Covid-19 Booster Shot (3rd dose)



No Vaccination Fees

All expense is paid for by the government.

Vaccination in Japan has high level of preventive efficacy, but it has been indicated that the infection control declines over time, particularly for elderly people. The 3rd dose can increase the effectiveness in preventing infections and serious diseases.

Joyo City provided a system that will allow all citizens to have access to the vaccine.

Regarding Booster Shot

Additional vaccination is available to those who are 18 yrs. old and above; and whose 2nd vaccination date has already elapsed a certain period of time (Refer to the table below). You may make a reservation once you get this notification

Eligibility	Date for your 3rd vaccination
Medical personnel, residents and workers of elderly facilities, etc.	6 months after 2nd vaccination
Elderly people (those who will reach the age of 65 or older by March 31, 2022)	7 months after 2nd vaccination (After March 1, shorten to 6 months)
Those other than mentioned above	8 months after 2nd vaccination (From March 1, shortened to 7 months)

● Those for whom vaccination is especially recommended

- Persons who have high severity risk such as elderly and/or those with underlying medical conditions.
- Persons in contact with people who are at high risk (e.g. elderly care workers)
- Persons at high risk virus exposure due to their occupation such as healthcare workers.

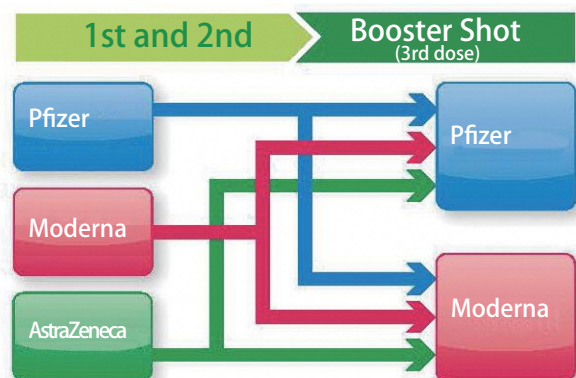
Information on the vaccines used for booster shot

Vaccine manufactured by Pfizer or Takeda/Moderna is used.

It does not have to be the same vaccine as the 1st and 2nd dose. For example, those who had Pfizer vaccine for the 1st & 2nd dose can still have Takeda/Moderna vaccine for the 3rd inoculation.

Type of vaccine varies depending on the clinic.
Takeda/Moderna vaccine is used for mass vaccination.

You may choose different vaccine from 1st and 2nd inoculation.



Reservation for vaccination

Dates you can get a booster shot is listed above. Please make a reservation after confirming your 2nd vaccination date written on your Certificate of Vaccination.

(Example) If you had your 2nd dose on July 15, 2021, you'll be able to have a booster shot on/or after February 15, 2022.



How to fill your pre-vaccination screening questionnaire

Listed points you should pay attention to for you not to miss any requirements.

This questionnaire has an attached vaccination voucher.

Please fill all the questions within blue squares and bring it to the vaccination site.

Your body temperature will be checked at the site on the day.

- 1 Please check the applicable part
- 2 Please make sure that the information on your vaccination certificate and record of vaccination is the same. If the information is different, please contact the customer service.
- 3 Refer to the section (あ) below.
- 4 Please read attached "Vaccination Manual" and check "Yes"
- 5 If your answer is "Yes," please consult with your doctor before coming to the vaccination site.
- 6 Please check the box next to "I want to be vaccinated" and sign with your name.

 If you forget the documents, we may not be able to administer the vaccine.

● Cautions



- ① If you are concerned about the vaccination because of your underlying treatment or health condition, **consult with your primary care doctor. Reservation should be made with doctor's permission.**
- ② Please wear short sleeve shirt or blouse as you will be asked **to expose your upper arm/shoulders.**
- ③ If you are an elderly person with mobility problems, please bring a family member with you if possible.



● Consent to be vaccinated

Covid-19 vaccination is not mandatory. The vaccination will be given only by the recipient's consent.

Please read the enclosed "Instructions for Covid Vaccination" beforehand, as you will be asked about this matter during the preliminary examination.

● Vaccination outside of Jojo, Uji and Kumiyama

- ① Those who wish to be vaccinated at the hospital or at the facility where they are admitted
Those who have an underlying medical condition and wish to be vaccinated at a medical institution where they are undergoing treatment
Consult with your doctor at the facility.
- ② Persons who registered at Jojo City but resides in other municipality
You may get vaccinated where you currently live. Please check with コロナワクチンナビ on web or inquire to the municipality you live.

● Things to bring on the day of vaccination

(Bring 1 to 3, otherwise you may not get vaccinated.)

① Vaccination Certificate, Vaccination Ticket and Pre-vaccination Screening Questionnaire

- Please detach and bring both
- Please fill out the pre-vaccination screening questionnaire in advance and bring it with you.

② ID (Residence Card, Driving License, Health Insurance Card, etc.)

③ Medical records or prescriptions (If applicable)

Let's stop it!

Vaccination is not mandatory.

- Some people cannot or do not want to be vaccinated for a variety of reasons such as pre-existing conditions.
- Vaccination is not compulsory, it is something that people do of their own will. Please do not inadvertently ask people whether they have been vaccinated or not; and do not discriminate against those who have not been vaccinated.
