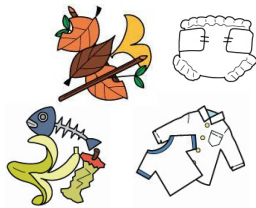
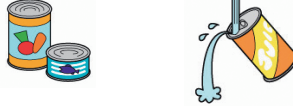
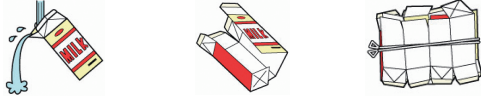


# Household Waste Sorting Guide

Please use clear transparent or white semi-transparent bags only.  
Please put out garbage by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day. Do NOT put it out the day before or during the night.

| <div>Burnable Garbage</div> <div>Twice a Week</div>                                                   | <div><div><div>● Food Waste ● Paper scraps ● Disposable Diapers (dispose of waste in the toilet first)</div><div>● Wood scraps (max. 5cm thick, 50 cm long) ● Branches (max. 5 cm thick, 50 cm long; tie with string if not bagged)</div><div>● Clothing (no zippers or buttons) ● Dirty plastic-marked products</div></div><div><div>* Newspapers, magazines, and cardboard are not collected. Please take them to a community or private collection sites.</div><div>* Agricultural waste (fruit/vegetable scraps from farms) is not accepted. | <div>Non-Burnable Garbage</div> <div>Twice a Month</div>                                              | <div><div><div>● Blankets/bedding ● Ceramics (bowls, pottery, etc.) ● Glass items ● Metal items (frying pans, kettles, etc.)</div><div>● Small appliances (heater, microwave, fan, vacuum cleaners, etc.)</div><div>● Branches / wood (max. 7 cm thick, 100 cm long) ● Light bulbs and fluorescent tubes</div><div>● Rubber and leather items ● Clothing (with zippers / synthetic fibers)</div><div>● Disposable warmers / desiccants / ice packs ● <b>Plastics (excluding “plastic recyclables”)</b></div><div>● <b>Furniture (under 1 m)</b></div></div><div><div>* For fluorescent tubes and small appliances, please try to use the recycling drop-off points located at public facilities throughout the city whenever possible.</div><div>* Wrap knives, sharp objects, or broken glass in paper, label them "DANGER" ( ケケン - Kiken) on the outside, and place them in a transparent or semi-transparent bag.</div></div></div> <div></div>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                      |
| <div>Plastic Recyclables</div> <div>Once a Week</div>                                                 | <div><div><div>◎  Items with Plastic Mark</div><div>● Bags/wrappers/labels ● Cups/containers ● Foam trays/Styrofoam ● Bottles ● Tubes</div><div>● Other similar items</div><div>* <u>Dirty plastic items with the Plastic Mark should be disposed of as Burnable Garbage.</u></div></div><div><div>◎ 100% Plastic Products (Must meet ALL conditions below)</div><div>① Under 50 cm ② Less than 5 mm thick ③ Fits in a 45L bag ④ Must be clean</div><div>● Food containers (Tupperware) ● Straws ● CDs/CD cases ● Buckets/wash basins ● Sponges</div><div>● Storage cases ● Other similar items</div><div>* <u>Items NOT meeting these conditions must be disposed of as Non-Burnable Garbage.</u></div></div></div> <div></div>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                      |
| <div>Empty Cans</div> <div>Every Other Week</div>                                                     | <div><div><div>● <b>Aluminum and steel cans for beverages and food.</b></div><div>Rinse the inside with water, then place it in a clear transparent or white semi-transparent bag.</div></div><div><div>* Large square cans (known as Ittokan or 18-liter cans, often used for cooking oil or kerosene) cannot be disposed with regular cans. | <div>Glass Bottles</div> <div>Every Other Week</div>                                                  | <div><div><div>● <b>Glass bottles (drinks, food, and seasonings)</b></div><div>Rinse the inside with water, then place it in a clear transparent or white semi-transparent bag.</div></div><div><div>* Glass cosmetic containers, glassware (cups, etc.) are not accepted. | <div>PET Bottles</div> <div>Twice a Month</div>                                                       | <div><div><div> ● Bottles with the PET mark</div><div>Rinse and place in a clear transparent or white semi-transparent bag.</div></div><div><div>* Please crush them as much as possible before disposal.</div><div>* <b>Remove caps and labels and dispose of them on “Plastic Recycling” days.</b></div></div></div> <div></div>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                 |

| <div>Oversized Items</div> <div>By Appointment, Available Three Times a Week (Tue., Thu., Fri.)</div> | <div><div><div>● Reservation required; collection fee applies (cash only)</div><div>● Furniture, hobby items, and other items measuring 1 m or more but less than 2 m</div><div>● <b>Reception number: 0774-82-3929 (Chuo Environmental Conservation Co., Ltd.( 中央環境保全株式会社 ) )</b></div></div><div><div>* If the item can be broken down or folded to under 1 meter, you may tie it with string and dispose of it for free on "Non-Burnable Waste" collection days.</div><div>* Place the items outside (for apartments: at ground level, outside the building).</div></div></div> <div></div>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                        |
| <div>Household Appliances Subject to Recycling Laws</div>                                             | <div><div><div>The following items <b>cannot be collected.</b> Please dispose of the item using <u>either method ① or ② below.</u></div><div>● <b>Designated items: Televisions (CRT, LCD, plasma, OLED), Refrigerators/freezers, Washing machines/clothes dryers, Air conditioners (including outdoor units).</b></div><div>① [Request Pickup]: Contact the store where you purchased the item or a participating appliance recycling partner (such as Edion Alplaza Joyo Store or Joshin Joyo Inter Store) to arrange for pickup. Recycling and collection/transportation fees apply.</div><div>② [Self-disposal]: After purchasing a Home Appliance Recycling Ticket at the post office, please bring the appliance to one of the designated collection facilities below.</div></div><div><div>● Shimazaki Transport ( 嶋崎運送 )Co., Ltd. 57-4 Yokooji rokutanhata, Fushimi-ku, Kyoto ( 京都市伏見区横大路六反畑 57-4)Tel: 075-604-6055</div><div>● Hokutsuu ( 北通 )Co., Ltd. 15-1 Misu Ikedayashiki-cho, Yokooji, Fushimi-ku, Kyoto ( 京都市伏見区横大路三栖池田屋敷町 15-1)Tel: 075-621-0045</div></div><div><div>* Recycling fees vary depending on the manufacturer and model. | <div>Items Unavailable for Collection</div>                                                           | <div><div><div>● Vehicle parts (tires, batteries, etc.) ● Steel drum container ● Pesticides/toxic chemicals ● Gasoline/kerosene/oils</div><div>● Paints ● LP gas cylinders ● Pianos ● Farming equipment ● Fire extinguishers</div><div>● Commercial waste (industrial waste, construction waste)</div><div>● Soil, sand, and concrete ● Safes ● Buddhist altars, etc.</div></div><div><div>* Please consult the store where you purchased the item or a specialized company.</div><div>* Soil, sand, concrete, safes, and Buddhist altars may be accepted if you bring them to the Sanitation Center yourself (fees apply).
